

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Fox Leaf or Oak Leaf Book Mark Instructions

Fox instructions

Colour the maple leaf, eyes and ears.

Have an adult cut the leaf, the eyes and ears out.

Glue the ears to the top tips of the leaf.

Paste on your eyes and draw a nose.

Oak Book Mark

Colour the Oak leaf. Have an adult help you write a saying such as “Fall into a Book” or “Leaf Through Some Pages.”

With the assistance of an adult, cut the dotted lines on either side of the top part of the leaf to make two slits. This will help your leaf hold the page in your book.





Make a Scarecrow Paper Bag Puppet

Using the paper bag that your craft kit came in, turn it into a cute puppet!

Have an adult help you with scissors.



1. Use the bag's flat bottom for the face with the flap as a mouth.
2. Colour and cut out the eye templates on this page.
3. Use yellow construction paper strips for hair.
4. Draw a triangle on the orange to make a nose
5. Draw a hat on the brown paper
6. Use the button template to draw buttons or colour the template.
7. Colour the leaf templates to make decorations for your scarecrow.
8. Don't forget to draw some clothes on your scarecrow and a mouth.
